Reflecting on 40 years of ministry

As 2025 ends, we often pause to reflect on the past year. This year started off with such joy and excitement as we held multiple events to celebrate 40 years of ministry in Northern Haiti. Prayer events, a celebration gala, and special services were held over the course of the week to celebrate this important milestone. The Sunday morning service included honoring founding Pastor Emmanuel Laguerre (Pastor Manno) and his vision to see Northern Haiti transformed through the gospel of Jesus Christ and celebrating Pastor Bobanoit Luceus's (Pastor Bob) leadership for the last 10 years. The week was a wonderful celebration of all the lives that have been impacted through the ministry of HCM. We were excited to have two of our board members to be able to attend after several years of inability to visit Haiti in person.



The year took a heartbreaking turn when Pastor Bob was called home to Jesus in March. While we miss Pastor Bob and his passion, leadership, and friendship, the ministry has continued. Churches continued to thrive and our schools continue to educate the next generation of Haitians. Our local leaders stepped up to lead while we searched for a new field director to provide in country leadership for all our pastors school leaders.

August brought news of our new field director, Pastor Marc-Aurel Fenelus. Pastor Marc-Aurel was an answer to prayer as his experience, including a history with HCM, provided us with a steady new leader. Pastor Marc-Aurel has jumped right in, getting engaged quickly within the Pillatre community and all the churches of HCM. He has created several videos highlighting the ministry and impact of HCM.

Growth has been a continued theme this year as well. Lory has begun to build a new sanctuary to accommodate the growth of the church. We have nearly 1500 students enrolled across 3 communities. We are in the process of adding a new maternity ward to our Pillatre medical clinic to provide critical care to pregnant women.
