The team from Dillon Community Church of Colorado arrived in Pillatre on February 10<sup>th</sup> for our annual trip to work in the clinic and share God's love. As we stocked the pharmacy shelves and prepared the medical rooms, we learned one of our hometown residents from Silverthorne, Colorado won the first American medal in the Winter Olympics in South Korea. What a context to witness how the world shrinks each year!

Enjoying the apartments at Pillatre, our team of 13 was able to take advantage of being on the campus with extra time to prepare, rest and explore the area. One of the highlights was an afternoon Prayer Walk led by our Mission Team Coordinator, Willeme Vixamar. We were able to visit, pray, and spread God's love with some of the Welcome Home Haiti residents. We spent a total of three days serving patients at Pillatre and Lory, then split one day between the new church at Haut Dehaine and a local orphanage. After years of viewing the Citadel from afar,



we traveled to the landmark early our last morning to view on foot (and horseback) this impressive piece of Haitian history.

Evidence of improvement was visible everywhere, from the extra roads paved and new building construction, to the efficient brick operation at

the Welcome Home Haiti property, and the thriving churches at Lory and Haut Dehaine. What a joy and blessing to know that the efforts of so many Haitian people, in tandem with the prayers and support from many friends abroad, are creating a better world on this beautiful island. Know that we see God's hand at work through both the good and the bad...and that we are His instruments, used for every good work according to our individual and collective talents. ## Pouring into new leaders

We have shared how we continue to be led to go to additional areas to share the Gospel in Northern Haiti.
