# Meeting a Medical need

It feels like it has been a while since we have had a team in country and a really



long time since we had a medical team. One team recently had to cancel, but in an answer to prayer, we were finally able to get a team from Dillion, Colorado into Haiti. It had been 5 months since the last team had been able to see hundreds of Haitians that need medical care. As we have mentioned before, in most of Haiti

medical attention is not readily available. If they do happen to have medical

care nearby, it is very costly and not something most Haitians will seek out. These medical teams are so very important and a core to the mission of HCM to meet the physical needs of the people.

From our Mission team coordinator, Willeme Vixamar, "We felt so happy to have this great team. After that long, people became sicker. They had the opportunity to be seen by this team. They felt excited again to receive medical care. So many people were seen. And some sicker people will be sent to Milot and New Hope hospitals to receive further medical care. We praise the name of God for all he is doing in the ministry."

The team was able to go to all of our churches (Pillatre, Lory, Haut DeHaine, Difou, and Riviere

Sable) over the course of the week. We are so very thankful for the sacrifice that each team member made to travel to Haiti and provide care to those in great need. And we praise God that he continues to allow us to be His hands and feet!



## **Leadership Training and Serving**



Right after the medical team left, a leadership conference was held at Pillatre. This leadership conference coincided with Pastor Bob returning from a leadership conference he attended in the US. Eighty-Seven attendees from Northern Haiti came to Pillatre for a day of learning and encouragement. One the highlights on day one was an interview with Pastor Bob. On day two they went to the orphanage at Rivere Sable to visit. Not only did they get to spend time with the children, they also helped serve the meal that day. In addition, the team modeled Jesus as they washed the feet of everyone at the conference.
