Difou

We recently asked Pastor Noseben and Sister Phida to provide an update on their ministry at Difou (Dufour). If you are not familiar with Difou, it is our fourth church plant. The church is about 30 minutes North-Northwest of Pillatre. Situated at the base of a mountain, this church has grown from being an outreach started by Emmaus University to a growing and vibrant church. The church originally met in a villager's yard before moving to its own property and getting a basic structure. The hike to Difou is a beautiful and allows for meeting many people as this remote village does not have a road for access.



From Phida: Our church is poor economically but rich spiritually. We



have more members every month. Now we are 200 members. We are praying for God to provide us a new building (church) because our current building is too small sometimes. There are times when we cannot fit everyone inside our church. We would also like to have a generator and sound system. Because the village is very small and remote, we have more than 20 children who don't go to school. Dufour is a community poorer than every place I know in Haiti. But I pray for God to open a ministry to help provide food for the community.

Our prayers are:

- More people will have houses
- More people to come to Jesus
- All children can go to school
- Have a ministry to help with providing housing and food.

We know with God; all things are possible!
