Shelley Hari of Welcome Home Haiti have a great connection with this organization. They invited us to attend this training with their key leaders. Among our leaders were the Field Director, the Campus Manager, the Missionary Team Coordinator, the HCM accounting leader, pastor Jacques from Lorry and a high school representative. The three days training was put on by US based resources including a former Army member. They emphasized many strenuous and complicated situations that have become a bit more common in Haiti recently. They talked through scenarios and ways to protect your lives from kidnapping, handling situations in some dangerous areas in Haiti, looking out for



other's who accompany you, ways to facilitate or engage in a negotiation, how to communicate in time of crisis, and strategies to implement a security framework in an organization. It was a great time of theory and tough time of practice, but it was worth it. While these are not always the most pleasant topics to discuss, we are thankful for the opportunity to learn.
