"It is with great joy to introduce myself. I am Pastor Jaccene SAINT- VIL, a devoted servant of God and a passionate shepherd of His people. With a heart rooted in the Word and a life committed to prayer and discipleship, I lead with humility, wisdom, and unwavering faith. I am married and have two children"



How long have you been pastor of Longues church? Jaccene: "I've been pastor of Longues church for 7 years". **How has Haitian Christian Ministries impacted the community of Longues?** Jaccene: "Haitian Christian Ministries (HCM) has had a meaningful and lasting spiritual impact on the community of Longues. Through consistent preaching of the Gospel, discipleship programs, and community outreach, HCM has helped cultivate a deeper understanding of God's Word and a stronger walk with Christ among individuals and families.

The presence of the church in Longues, supported by HCM, has become a spiritual home where people gather not only for worship, but also for prayer, encouragement, and growth. Many lives have been transformed, people have come to know Jesus as their personal Savior, marriages have been restored, and young people have been mentored in faith and leadership. HCM also invests in spiritual formation through Bible studies, youth ministry, and leadership training, equipping believers to be active in the Kingdom and lights in their community. The spiritual revival in Longues is a direct result of HCM's commitment to building up the church and pointing hearts toward Christ".

What is your vision for the next 3-5 years? Past Jaccene: "We aim to become a regional center for discipleship, expand our outreach ministries, strengthen family life programs, and raise new generations of leaders to serve both locally and globally. **Tell us about Spiritual Development, Assessing encouraging growth?** Past Jaccene: "We use small groups, spiritual check-ins, and one-on-one discipleship relationships. Teaching series often include reflection guides and accountability tools. Discipleship programs: We have a clear discipleship pathway, including a new believer class, mentorship pairs, Bible study groups, and leadership development tracks. -Supporting spiritual depth: Through weekly sermons rooted in Scripture, intentional prayer gatherings, fasting periods, and personal spiritual coaching, we guide members to grow closer to Christ".

key challenges that affect both daily life and long-term development: 1. Limited Economic Opportunities: Many families in Longues struggle with poverty due to a lack of stable jobs and resources. Agriculture is often the main source of income, but it's vulnerable to weather and environmental conditions. 2. Access to Education: While there is a growing effort to improve schooling, resources remain limited. Many children may not have access to quality education or basic supplies. 3. Healthcare Access: Medical care is not always easily accessible or affordable. This leads to untreated illnesses and a lack of preventive care. 4. Spiritual Needs: Although the church is growing, there is still a great need for discipleship, spiritual maturity, and guidance to combat hopelessness and cultural pressures. 5. Youth Vulnerability: With limited options, young people can be tempted by negative influences or may leave the community in search of a better future elsewhere".



Ministry updates and needs

We, as the HCM Board, wanted to provide some important ministry updates and make all our supporters aware of some pressing financial needs within the ministry. The HCM board of directors continues to meet on a regular basis, both as a board and with leaders in Haiti to provide direction and leadership during this transition time prior to the hiring of a new Field Director. The board is actively working on hiring a new Field Director. Please pray with us through this process. We hope to have an announcement very soon on who will be continuing the vision and ministry started by Pastor Manno and Pastor Bob.

Urgent Ministry Needs

1. The batteries for the solar system that powers our Pillatre Campus have come to the end of their lives. We have a very temporary solution that is providing power to the campus right now. The solution involves power rationing; only certain buildings receive power on certain days of the week. Replacement of all batteries for the campus will cost \$30,000 US. Can you help provide solar power to Pillatre campus?
2. We have 1500 students enrolled in our 3 HCM schools. Child sponsorship provides the bulk of our funding. At present we only have 41% of our students sponsored. Can you help increase that number?
3. The medical clinic will soon be providing maternity delivery services on the Pillatre Campus. The total cost for building renovations and medical equipment for the project is estimated at \$75,000-\$80,000. The Maternity Project is currently funded at \$38,000 or almost 50%. Can you help to provide safe medical care for pregnant mothers and their infants?
