## Boukan Michel church

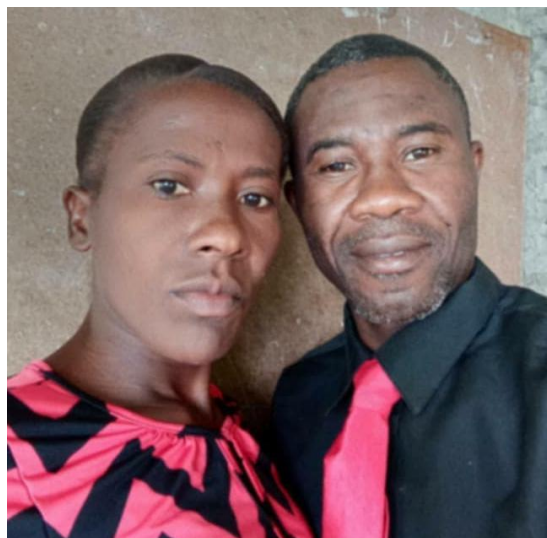

We want to continue to highlight the churches of HCM and their pastor. Boukan Michel – A Place of Passion, Perseverance, and the Power of the Gospel. Boukan Michel is one of the most remote areas in the Northern Department of Haiti, a place where access is incredibly difficult. Reaching this mountain village requires a four-hour hike, either on foot or by animal. And yet, despite the challenges, the Gospel is alive and thriving, thanks to the dedication and vision of Haitian Christian Ministries (HCM).



The church is led by Pastor Jacky Diverge, a man with a deep heart for God and for his people. With patience, love, and unwavering determination, he shepherds this community faithfully, even though the conditions are far from easy.

The church also runs a school, which, though active, is still in need of support. Today, the church in Boukan Michel has around 220 active members who travel from neighboring areas to worship together every Sunday. What's truly powerful is the hunger these people have for the Word of God. They don't just listen to the Gospel, they live it. Their spirit of unity, service, and passion is contagious. Many young people are



actively involved, bringing hope for the spiritual future of the entire region. HCM is making a powerful impact in Boukan Michel, not just through preaching, but by strengthening communities and building lives. They equip leaders, provide access to Scripture and biblical training, and serve as a light in one of Haiti's darkest corners.

But HCM's mission doesn't stop there. The ministry is faithfully working to spread the light of Christ throughout every corner of Northern Haiti, even in the hardest-to-reach places. Through this work, thousands of families who once had no access to hope are now encountering the truth of the Gospel. Boukan Michel stands as a living testimony that the Gospel can reach anywhere if we're willing to go. God is using HCM to transform lives, raise leaders, and bring light into every mountain and valley where darkness once ruled. We continue to pray for Boukan Michel, for Pastor Jacky, and for the mission. And we
